STGi is one of 15 new corporate partners that will be inducted on June 29, 2011; some of the new corporate partners for the MSEP include Microsoft, the Navy Federal Credit Union, Home Depot, Starbucks, Fort Sill and Fort Hood National Banks, and Johns Hopkins Medicine.

"STGi is honored to be one of the first 15 new corporate partners inducted into the MSEP," says President & CEO Michelle S. Lee. "This is a program that makes sense for us to participate in – we are already working on the bases, so we should be hiring the spouses!"
