STG International, Inc. Wins Six U.S. Navy Contracts Totaling Approximately \$81.3 Million to Provide Medical Services at Navy Facilities

– Awards Highlight Contractor’s Ability to Provide Expert Medical Staffing –

Alexandria, VA – Dec. 1, 2006 – STG International, a premier provider of medical, professional and technical services to the federal government, has been awarded six contracts by the U.S. Navy to provide multidisciplinary services, ancillary services, medical/surgical services, primary care services and nursing services. The total value of the contracts over varying multi-year periods is worth approximately \$81.3 million. A summary of the contracts follows:

- **NW MATO:** This \$10 million contract is to provide multidisciplinary healthcare services for Northwest region hospitals. With the first task order on the contract, STG International is to staff the Naval Hospital Oak Harbor Women’s Clinic in Washington State with labor and delivery nurses, physicians, registered nurses, licensed practical nurses and certified nursing assistants.
- **NE MATO:** This \$18 million contract is to provide multidisciplinary healthcare worker services in 30 states and the District of Columbia in the Northeast region. The first two task orders are to provide managed care, behavioral health, neonatal intensive care, pharmacy, radiology, pulmonary medicine and laboratory support to the National Naval Medical Center in Bethesda, MD.
- **Ancillary Services:** This \$4 million contract is to provide ancillary healthcare services for military treatment facilities in California, Arizona and Nevada. The first task order is to support the Physical Therapy services department at Naval Medical Center San Diego. Staffing support includes physical therapists, physical therapist assistants, occupational therapy and occupational therapy assistants.
- **Medical/Surgical Services:** This \$33 million contract is to provide medical/surgical services to medical treatment facilities in California, Arizona and Nevada. The first task order is to provide a range of primary care providers and health care workers at Naval Medical Center San Diego that include family practice doctors, internal medicine doctors, pediatricians and registered nurses.
- **Primary Care Services:** This \$10.9 million contract is to provide primary care services to the Primary Care Clinic Clairemont, part of the Primary Care Network for Naval Medical Center San Diego. The contract will fill more than 22 positions with physicians, nurse practitioners, registered nurses and telemetry technicians.

- **Nursing Services:** This \$5.4 million contract will provide staffing support for the Mental Health Clinic, Nursing Directorate, Naval Medical Center San Diego.
